



2010-2011 STUDENT SUPPLY LIST

Most student supply list items are expected during the first week of school. **PLEASE REMEMBER TO LABEL ALL BACKPACKS, LUNCH BOXES AND CLOTHING WITH YOUR STUDENT'S FIRST AND LAST NAME IN PERMANENT MARKER OR WITH A SEWN LABEL.** If they are not labeled they may be labeled by the teacher in permanent marker. Some items may become community property. Due to the roll-out of the curriculum, however, not all items will be used immediately. Teachers may periodically request additional supplies during the school year. Students are expected to report to school **EACH DAY** with the proper instructional supplies.
