

WHAT: Vaccines for Children (immunizations clinics)

WHEN: Throughout Summer 2010

WHERE: Any Federally Qualified Health Center

DETAILS: Did you know your child is required to be immunized in order to attend school? Be sure to get your child immunized before school starts! The Immunization Program at the Department of Health provides free vaccines through the Vaccines for Children (VFC) Program to providers enrolled in the VFC that vaccinate children meet the qualifications below.

- Are eligible for Medicaid
- Have no health insurance
- Have health insurance, but it does not cover immunizations AND go to a federally qualified health center
- Are Native American or Alaskan Native
